Policies and Procedures

Ballet/ Pointe Placement: Placement is determined individually based on ability, strength, and potential. Students may be moved between levels as they develop. Pointe work begins only after continual evaluation and teacher recommendation. Additional classes may be added with parent approval (fees apply).

Performance Opportunities: All students are able to perform in our End-of-Year Production in May. Our elite Performing Company presents a Nutcracker Tea in December and competes in the spring. To learn more, contact: info@englishtheatrearts.com.

Costumes: Costumes are ordered in November. Costume fees must be paid by **October 15th** to participate in the production. One costume fee is included in the production fee package.

Pictures: Picture day is held at the studio during the spring. Details announced closer to date.

Production & Dress Rehearsal: Mandatory for all students. Missing rehearsal may result in exclusion from the production.

Parent Volunteers: We need volunteers during rehearsal and production! Opportunities include Room Moms, prop help, sewing, and more. A sign-up will be sent out later in the year.

Late- Enrollment: Students who **enroll after November 1** may not be able to perform unless costumes can still be ordered and arrive on time.

Tuition Commitment: Tuition covers 34 weeks of classes, divided into **9 equal payments with the first payment September 1st, and the last being May 1st**. Tuition remains the same regardless of the number of weeks in each month. Tuition is due on the **1st of each month**. A **late fee of \$10** will be added if not paid by **the 10th**. We understand that emergencies arise, so please contact us as soon as possible. Tuition is NOT prorated due to student absences. If the student misses, they are allowed to make up the class in another age-appropriate class.

Withdrawal Policy: There is a **30-day written notice policy** for students to withdraw from classes. Student accounts will continue to be charged until this notice is received. Please note all accounts with outstanding balances at the end of the year will be turned over for collection. No students will be allowed to perform in the end-of-the-year production with an outstanding balance.

Class Enrollment/ Cancellations: On **September 30th** class enrollment will be reviewed. Classes that have less than 5 students may be closed or combined. If changes are made, the new schedule will be released on **October 1**.

Forms of Communication: We typically communicate through email and class announcements. We also use the Band app for quick studio communication. Please email info@englishtheatrearts.com for any questions or concerns.
