Policies and Procedures

Ballet/ Pointe Placement: Placement for Ballet and Pointe classes are evaluated on an individual basis. Each student is placed in the class that is best suited for the student's current ability, strengths, desire, and potential. A student may begin in a particular class, and then move to another level. With parents' approval, additional classes may be added (Additional fees do apply). Students who show interest in pointe will be evaluated on a continual basis, and recommended to go on pointe when the teacher feels the dancer is strong enough and ready.

Performance Opportunities: There are multiple performance opportunities for all dancers. All dancers will be able to perform at the end of the production in May. English Theatre Arts Performing Company hosts a Nutcracker Tea in December. Dancers may choose to audition for Nutcracker in September. Costumes: Costumes are chosen and ordered in November. Costume fees must be paid by **October 15th** to participate in the production. Costume fees are included in the production fee package.

Pictures: We will have picture day at the studio with information to come at the end of the year.

Production & Dress Rehearsal: Dress Rehearsal for the production is in May (date coming soon) and **mandatory for ALL STUDENTS**. FAILURE TO SHOW FOR DRESS REHEARSAL CAN RESULT IN NOT BEING ALLOWED TO PERFORM IN THE PRODUCTION.

Parent Volunteers: During the Rehearsal/Production we will need parent volunteers. There are a variety of jobs from Room Moms, prop help, sewing, etc. We will send out a list of jobs along with a sign up sheet later in the year. We ask that you please consider volunteering.

End of Year Production: The end of the year Production will be in May, date coming soon. The production will include all classes and all dancers. You will receive detailed information about the production later in the year.

Late- Enrollment: If you enroll in a class after **November 1st**, there may be a chance you will not be able to participate in the end of year production. However, you may still enroll in the class if we are able to order the costume and it arrives on time.

Tuition Commitment: Tuition is for 33 weeks of dance classes. **We separate the yearly tuition into 9 equal payments with the first payment September 1st, and the last being May 1st.** While some months may have more weeks and others not as many, the tuition will remain the same each month. Tuition is due on the **1st of each month**. A **late fee of \$10** will be added if not paid by **the 10th**. We understand that emergencies arise, so please contact us as soon as possible. Tuition is NOT prorated due to student's absences. If the student misses, they are allowed to make up the class in another age appropriate class.

Withdrawal Policy: There is a **30 day written notice policy** for students to withdraw from classes. Student accounts will continue to be charged until this notice is received. Please note all accounts with outstanding balances at the end of the year will be turned over for collections. No students will be allowed to perform in the end of the year production with an outstanding balance.

Class Enrollment/ Cancellations: On **September 30th** class enrollment will be reviewed. Classes that have less than 4 students may be closed or combined. If changes are made, the new schedule will be released **October 1**.
