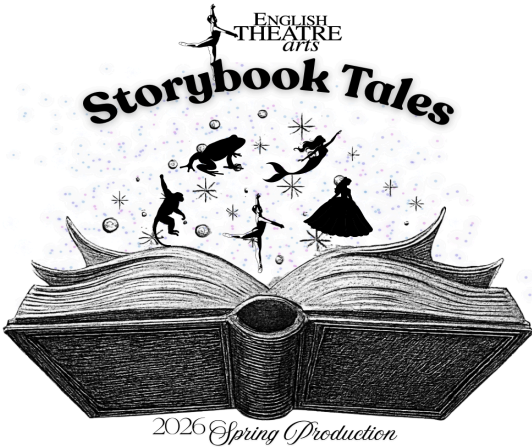

## Check-In & Production Day Details

- **Arrival Deadline:** 9:30 AM
- **All dancers must check in by this time**

### Lunch Options:

- Chick-fil-A lunch: \$12 (must [pre-register](#) & pay)
- OR bring your own lunch

### Important:

- Dancers must arrive with **hair & makeup completed**
- Must be **fully dressed and ready by 2:00 PM**
- Check-in and check-out required with a parent volunteer

 Only **one parent per dancer** may attend blocking rehearsal.

---

## Hair & Makeup Requirements

Hair and makeup are required for a polished stage appearance. Dancers should wear foundation, blush, brown/gold eyeshadow, eyeliner, mascara, and a neutral lip. Hair must be in a low bun with a middle part. **No jewelry or nail polish is allowed**, except small gold or silver stud earrings for newly pierced ears.

Please bring extra hair and makeup supplies for touch-ups. A full packing checklist is provided below (not all items apply to every dancer). **Skin-toned undergarments or leotards should match your dancer's skin tone.**

Small tooth comb and brush

Gel and hairspray

Hairnets

Blush

Brown/Gold Eyeshadow

Liquid and/or pencil eyeliner

Mascara

Fake Eyelashes (optional)

## Dressing Rooms

- Assigned at check-in
- Access limited to:
  - Parent volunteers
  - Instructors
  - Parents assisting with drop-off/pick-up

 Due to limited space, no lingering in dressing rooms. Quick-change tents will be available side stage.

---

## Backstage Guidelines

- Only **parent volunteers & instructors** may remain backstage
- Preschool/primary dancers may have **one parent stay (if needed)**
- One parent may escort dancers backstage, but must exit after

 No watching the full recital from backstage

---

## Final Notes

- Dancers must remain in assigned dressing rooms unless escorted
- Send **quiet, non-messy activities** (no markers)
- Pack snacks that won't stain costumes
- Label all costumes, shoes, and belongings

 Recommended: Tote or labeled bin for organization
